**Peripatetic Lessons for GCSE– 2018/2019**

As a GCSE music student, it is helpful for students to regularly attend a peripatetic music lesson in order to supplement their Music curriculum. These lessons are with professional teachers who specialise in the given instrument. In previous years, this has been solely funded by school and represented a significant investment.

As you will certainly be aware, schools – like all public services – are being forced to make difficult financial decisions. This means that, reluctantly, we are unable to continue to fully fund these lessons.

For the remainder of this academic year, these costs total £385, which will allow students to have a 20 minute private lesson with their tutor, once per week. We are advised that this strikes the best balance between value for money and impact. These payments can either be made in full; in an instalment of £128 twice per term with an additional one-off payment of £129, or in monthly instalments of £38.50.
