Your child has been selected to represent Arena Academy in curating the "Echo Eternal" exhibition held at Birmingham Central Library. Echo Eternal is a project that commemorates the Holocaust by showcasing the testimonies of 12 survivors alongside different creative arts. As a result, 12 videos have been created and exhibited at the library for all to appreciate what happened during the Holocaust. The work itself has been managed by local creative professionals and has included students from across CORE Education Trust.

As a school, we have been asked to curate the exhibition on Thursday 31st January from 9.30am - 3.30pm. This will include encouraging members of the public to visit the exhibition and challenging library goers to complete a quiz on how much they know already about the Holocaust. In preparation for this, students will be visiting the library on Wednesday 30th January to make themselves familiar with the exhibition.

Students will be expected to wear full school uniform and are asked to prepare a packed lunch for the day of the curation. Packed lunches can be provided by school if students receive free school meals and students and staff will travel by minibus to and from the library. We expect to arrive back at school by 4.15pm.
